Camp Activities - (group led) included in your site fees is our standard program package which includes access to:			
Archery - 8+ years old to participate; groups must provide their own archery rangemaster certified with Scouts Canada			
Tomahawks - 11+ years old to participate.			
Pelletry - 11+ years old to participate; Groups must provide their own pelletry rangemaster certified with Scouts Canada.			
Pioneering, Nature Programs, Swimming, Fire Lighting, Compass/Orienteering, Wide Games, Low Ropes, Swimming, Hikes, Waterpark (available end of June until end of August), Campfire Program, Survival, Snowshoes, X-Country Skis.			
Note: We do not provide lifeguards for the waterfront at Camp Woods. All groups are responsible for their own safety and waterfront supervision. Youth found at the beach area or dock without adult supervision will be asked to leave and return only when they have the required adult supervision.			
Camp Activities – High Adventure			
Aspire Challenge Tower – Thirty-five tall, the tower is designed to challenge youth Cub-age youth (8+) and older (minimum 50lbs) to break out of their comfort zone and climb, alone or in pairs. Each side of the tower gets progressively more difficult. Up to nine people can be on the climbing tower at one time provided there are enough trained personnel to assist with belaying. The tower is booked for a three hour session in either the morning 8:30 am-11:30 am or afternoon session 1:30-4:30 pm for \$150.			
Challenge Course – \$17.50/hour for a minimum of 2 hours, maximum of 3 hours; morning session 9:00 am-12:00 pm or afternoon session 1:00 pm-5:00 pm.			
Canoes and Paddleboards – \$10/canoe or \$10/paddle board a day Adult must always be present on the water while groups are using canoes/paddleboards. Groups using canoes must be under supervision of adult with provincially recognized canoe certification or equivalent canoe training, lifeguard certification, or swift water rescue certification.
